# The Avocet

With its refined black and porcelain-white plumage, needle-sharp uptilted bill and long legs, this is one of our most elegant wading birds. It has been the R.S.P.B logo for half a century, initially in full silhouette and later stylised as a head and shoulder image. For all its refinement, the avocet was pushed to extinction in the nineteenth century by a combination of marshland drainage, shooting, the collection of its feathers for fishing flies and its eggs for the table. On the Norfolk coast a local wild fowler recalled that he used to gather avocet's eggs, filling his cap, coat pockets, and even his stockings; and the poor people thereabouts made puddings and pancakes of them. We probably owe the avocet's modern breeding presence in Britain to Adolf Hitler. The flooding of vulnerable sections of the East Anglian coastline, and six wartime years completely without disturbance, formed the perfect background to the birds' recolonisation. Today there are at least 650 pairs breeding along the east and south coasts of England. The birds returned in the early spring of 1947, when four or five pairs settled at Havergate, a dune and shingle island. Simultaneously, four pairs also arrived at Minsmere, but such was the secrecy surrounding the parallel events that neither set of guardians watching over them informed their colleagues. The R.S.P.B.s headquarters were electrified by the news, and four volunteers were rushed to the site at



Havergate to keep watch and protect these birds until they hatched. Like much of the east coast, the island of Havergate was devastated by a huge tidal surge on the night of 31 January 1953, the avocets nesting ground was covered by a vast reservoir of more than a hundred million gallons of water to a depth of five feet or more. Remarkably, temporary repairs involving tens of thousands of sand bags ensured that the next avocet breeding season went off largely without a hitch, and the following winter the sea walls were completely rebuilt.

Such is the extent to which the R.S.P.B and its dedicated band of workers will go to bring the avocet and many other birds which are becoming extinct as a breeding species in this country back from the brink. Hopefully, in a couple of day's time I will be going down to the north Norfolk coast where I hope to see a few of these elegant wading birds at close quarters.
